

ADDITIONAL CAMP INFORMATION

Snacks, Water, Lunch and Medication

All camps are provided with allergy friendly snacks and water. We encourage all campers to bring a refillable water bottle. Full day camps are **REQUIRED** to bring a lunch. Please be aware that there are no utensils or appliances available for campers. Camp Teachers are not able to administer medications or sunscreen during the camp day. We ask that these are handled before camp.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Where do I go to drop off / pick up my child from camp?

A: Camper drop off and pick up will take place at our Field Station Door. (The Field Station is the old gift shop entrance/the small green building on the left as you enter to zoo's main gate.) Please look for the camp door sign.

Q: Who can drop off/ pick up my child?

A: Any adult may drop off your child for camp. Only adults that are on the approved pick up list, **with a photo id**, may pick up a child from camp. Additional names may be added to the list during drop off.

Q: Where do I go if I need to drop off my child late or pick up my child early?

A: Please head to our new gift shop (red doors at the center of the main walkway) and speak with our staff to begin the pick up procedure and a member of our camp staff will bring your child to the gift shop.

Q: How should my child dress for camp?

A: Much of the camp day will take place outdoors, around animals, in potentially wet and muddy environments. We ask that campers wear their camp t-shirt daily, weather appropriate bottoms, and closed toed shoes. (old tennis shoes will be great!)

Q: Will camp be cancelled due to rain?

A: No. Camp is a rain or shine event, and will not be cancelled unless the weather conditions are severely inclement (i.e. flooding, hurricane, tornado, etc.) If camp is to be canceled, our staff will contact parents through the email provided during registration.
