What Does Your Child Need to Bring?

- **LUNCH and WATER will be provided.**
 - Water bottle. Hydration is very important as your child will be active throughout the camp.
 - Closed-Toed Shoes. We will be walking around often and interacting with animals.
 - Breakfast (optional). Campers will have a breakfast-time icebreaker. Breakfast will not be provided.
 - Snacks (optional). Campers will have a minimum of a 15-minute snack break.
 - Cellphones are allowed but must remain in a pocket or backpack unless there is an emergency or speaking with a parent or contact person. Parents, please ensure your camper is aware of this rule so they do not disrupt others and get the most out of camp.

Drop-Off Protocol:

- Please make sure you accompany your child to the Education Dept. to get checked in.
 - Camp Teachers will ensure each child brings water, closed-toed shoes.
 - Camp teachers will ask for a signature before we accept your child for the day. If it is the first day your child is coming to camp, they will be given a camp T-shirt and directed to change in the bathroom.
 - Camp Teachers will confirm additional contact info and allergy/special needs info with you and be available to answer questions at this time.
 - Late drop-offs will be accepted, though your child may miss out on some activities during the time they are absent.
